

## Check List

The author(s) should check the manuscript by marking the boxes below.

- The paper has not been submitted for publication or published elsewhere.
- Human and/or animal studies in the article were approved by Institutional Review Board(s).
- The manuscript has been corrected by a native speaker of English (if referees judge that the manuscript requires editing of the English, the authors will be charged accordingly).
- Typing along with the Instructions for Authors throughout the text including references, table and figure legends.
- The manuscript is in the following order: (1) title page, (2) abstract and key words, (3) text, (4) acknowledgements, (5) references, (6) figure legends, (7) tables, and (8) figures.
- The title page contains all of the information indicated in Instructions for Authors.
- An additional English title page in the Japanese article.
- References are listed in the order appearing in the text and are consistent with samples in Information for Authors.
- The abstract in English is less than 250 words and less than 600 characters in Japanese.
- Key words (3-5 words)
- The author's name and figure numbers are written on the back of each photograph and/or illustration.
- The desired final size for photographs is indicated. Figures and photographs will be fitted to either a single column or a double column.
- The original plus 2 copies of the manuscript (each including all original tables and figures)
- Disk containing the title page and abstract in English (for rapid reviewing)
- Fill out the Submission Sheet and sign the Copyright Transfer Statement.
